 - 1. VCSAC
 - a. Talked about increasing tuition and if free tuition like NY is an option
 - b. Students fees has not increased in years despite inflation. \$35/student 22.80 is given to professional school.
 - c. Policy of the student conduct isn't really protecting the students

- d. There has been also some discrimination (student stories)

- 2. Targum Referendum Oversight Committee
 - a. Goals:

- 3. Sustainable Governance Committee
 - a. Discussed Student Governance's History.
 - Purpose is to make a report of the biggest issues that we are trying to hand in at the end of March
 - c. 2007, RUSA was created
 - d. Because of so the disconnect between councils, there is confusion between who is doing what efficiently.
 - When we pass something it is just us who passes them, not all the schools governing councils.
 - e. Discussed each governing council's function

- Funding is an issue that is faced by all councils- each Governing council has their own criteria and their own processes
